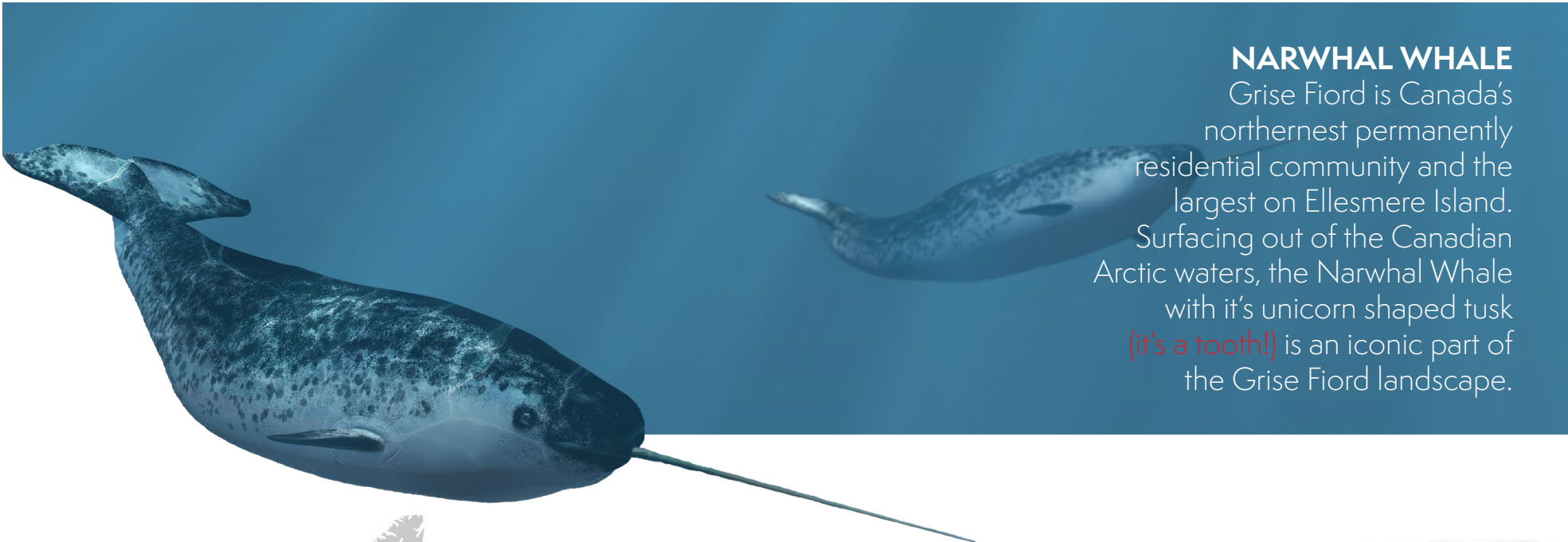


KIDS CORNER

KERMODE BEAR
Some of the westernmost coastal communities in Canada are on the Haida Gwaii, the homeland of the Haida people. On this coin, a Kermode Bear (*Spirit Bear*) is the symbol of Canada's Pacific coast.



NARWHAL WHALE

Grise Fiord is Canada's northernmost permanently residential community and the largest on Ellesmere Island. Surfacing out of the Canadian Arctic waters, the Narwhal Whale with its unicorn shaped tusk (*it's a tooth!*) is an iconic part of the Grise Fiord landscape.



With the longest coastline in the world, (*243 042 km*), we celebrate the iconic Canadian communities and the animals associated with them.

ATLANTIC PUFFIN

Cape Spear is Canada's easternmost point. The rugged coast of Atlantic Canada is home to many seabirds, including the striking Atlantic Puffin. (*sometimes called the "sea parrot"*) The Puffin is the official bird of Newfoundland and Labrador.
